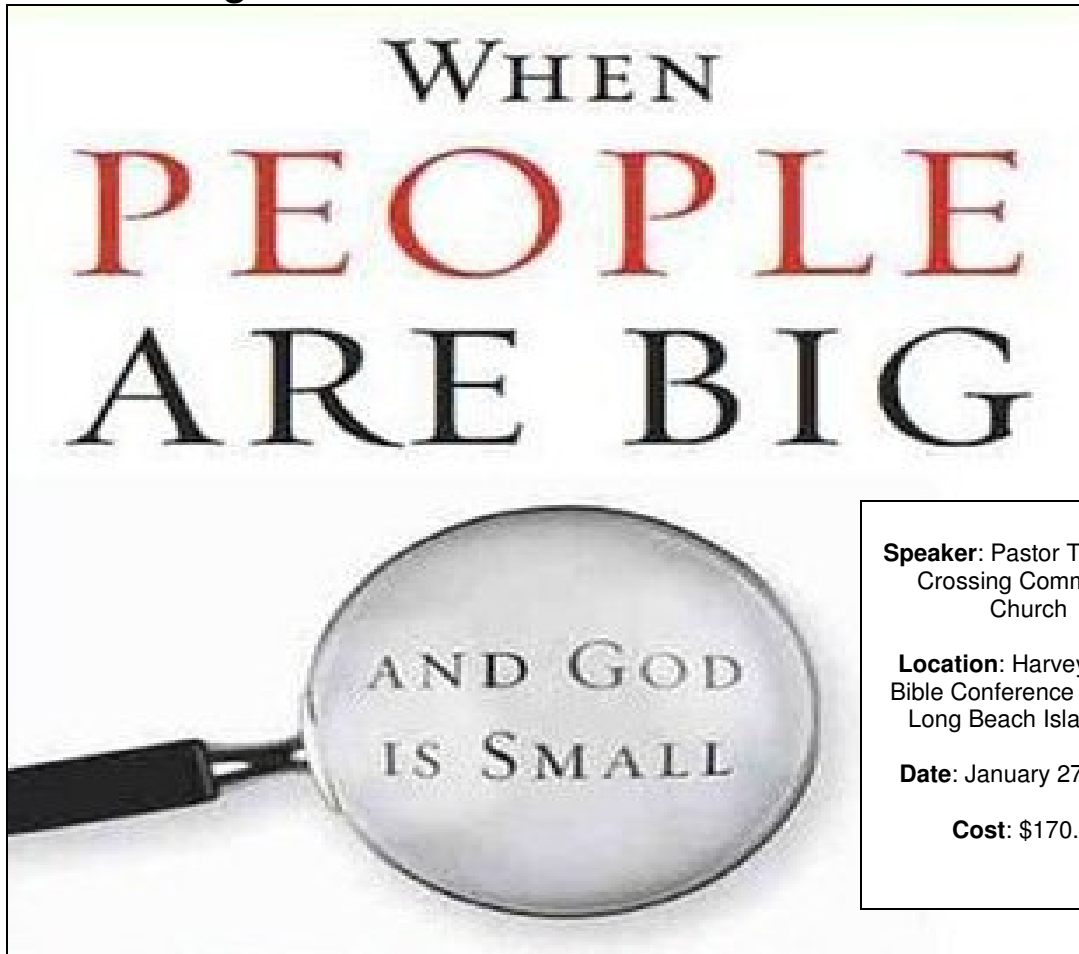


Langhorne Men's 2012 Winter Retreat
