

2012--30 Hour Famine Info Sheet

(Friday, February 24th – Saturday, February 25th)

Famine starts Friday at 6pm. When you come, you will need to check your youth in, and any guests in at that time.

You will need:

- a current permission slip (if you have not done this already, or if this is a new guest)
- your famine consent form
- \$15.00 per person to help cover costs of the event
- your Famine money to be turned in and counted- as you arrive at LPC
- sleeping bag, pillow, clothes for Saturday- make sure they are working and old clothes and shoes-some teams may be painting
- 1 gallon of juice
- 1 non-perishable item for our LPC food pantry
- labeled water bottle

Basic schedule:

Friday

- 6- check in
- 7- 9 photo scavenger hunt
- 9-11 games and devo's
- 11-12 sleeping arrangement set up
- 12- lights out

Saturday

- 7- wake up, pack up, clean up
- 8- devo's
- 8:30ish- 1:00ish off to ministry sites
- 1-5-chill time, game time, photo assembly time
- 5-6 closing devo (parents are invited)
- 6- break the fast- pizza party

Normal questions:

Are we encouraging your youth to go door to door to fund raise? No- that is entirely up to each family. But- we are encouraging each youth to ask 10 people for support. 10 people usually equals at least \$100.00 and that is the goal for each person to bring to the famine. So can you help mom and dad with encouragement and support?

If I volunteer to come- can I be with my youth? Yes, if your youth agrees, but remember you are here for all youth, not just yours

Can my youth be a part if they have a short schedule conflict? Yes, just be aware you are responsible for transportation- and you need to let me know ahead when they will be coming and going.

If I volunteer- can I bring my own children- yes- just make sure that they are safe and would not hinder your work- some ministry sites will not allow children under the age of 10- so make sure you speak to me ahead of time.

Famine closing and Sunday morning:

Closing ceremony at 5pm on Saturday- in which parents are invited and encouraged to attend- to see and celebrate what happened at the 30 Hour Famine as youth share about their ministry sites. After the 5pm service, the pizza party begins. Youth are dismissed following the pizza party that starts at 6pm. The serving and eating of pizza will take probably 30 minutes, after which time you are encouraged to gather your youth, their supplies and head home.

We will be sitting together in church on the right hand side, at the 9:45am service on Sunday, February 26th, have youth and all participants wearing their Famine T-shirts. We will also be presenting the Famine results. So, plan to be there please at 9:30am
