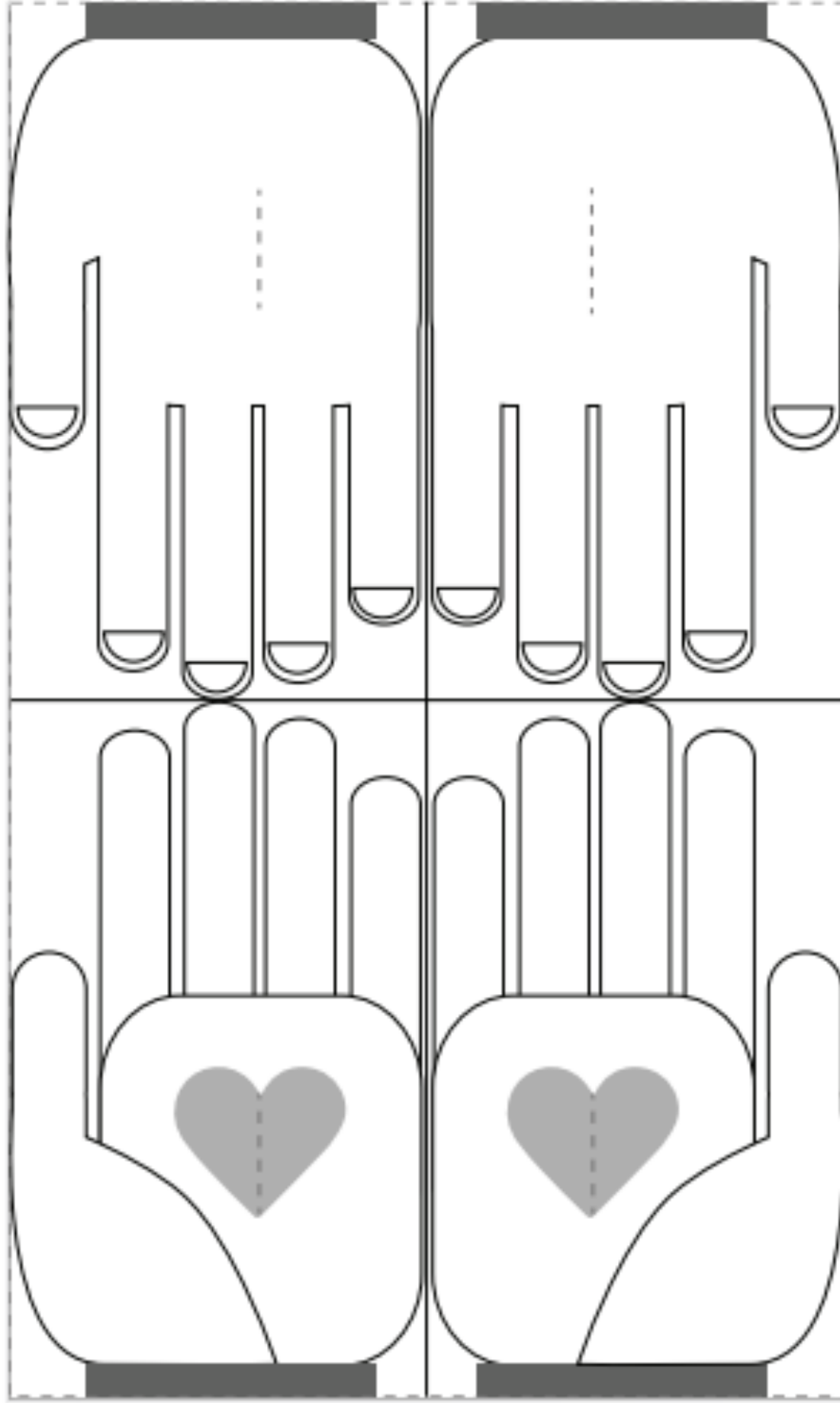

VERSES: 24-29



CUT along the dotted lines to cut out the hands. Also be sure to cut the 4 slits inside the hands. Then cut out the yellow ribbon shape.



FOLD the page twice along the purple lines. You want to fold it to make the shape of a pop-up greeting card.



POSE the sides of the ribbon through the hands' side first and make sure that they go through the other side of the hands.
