“ And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a might rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.

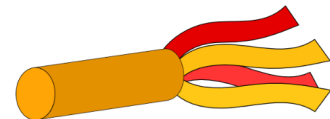
And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. “

Activities

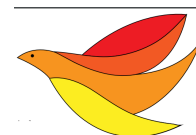
Pentecost Wind Socks

- Roll paper or cardstock into a tube and tape together. Use colored streamers to decorate the ends.



Dove + Flame Activity

- Use the attached template to create a Dove / Flame . Color the template to look like a flame. Depending on the way you hold it, the template can be a flame or a dove.



Wind Spirals

Make a template of a spiral for your child by drawing a circle and spiraling inward. The spirals should be about 2-3 cm thick. Have children decorate the paper. Cut along the lines of the spiral. Tape a piece of string to the innermost part of the spiral. Tell children that even though wind and air are invisible, they can move things, just like the Holy Spirit lives in us.
